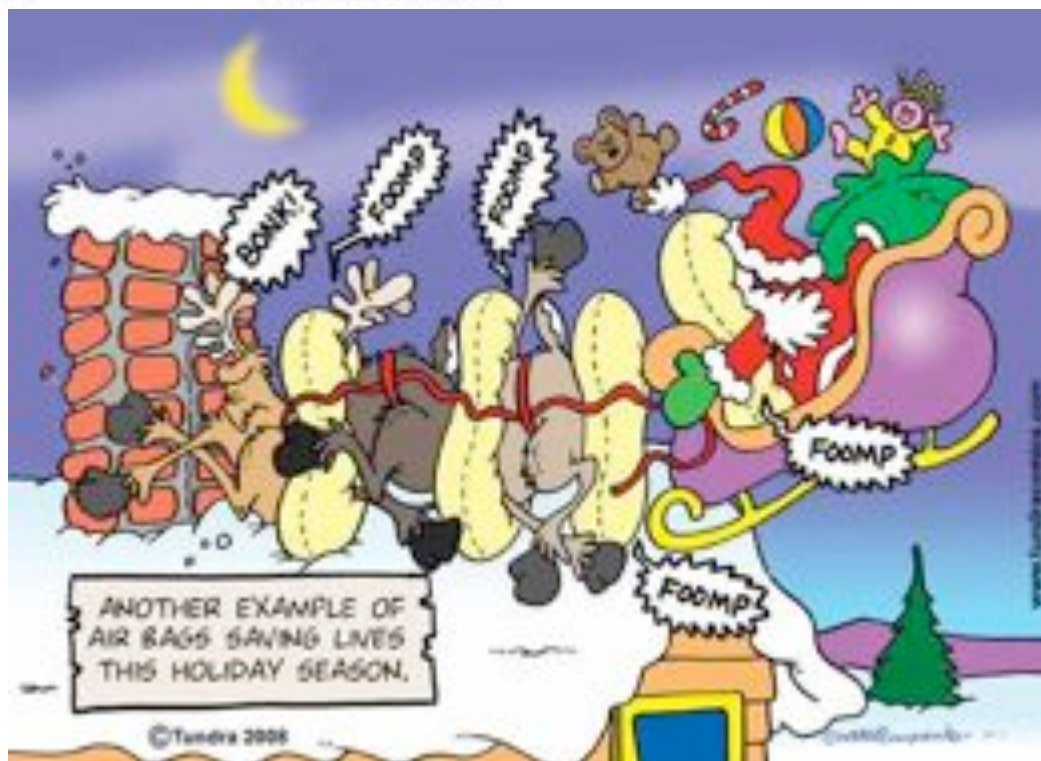

 - a. Agility Trial: Hank Hillard – The trial went very well, was very well received. Fifty new titles, including one MACH. Net income was \$5,606. Mary Lou Strayer thanked all of the workers.
 - b. Breeder Referral: Deb Bush – From August until last week we received and responded to nineteen inquiries.
 - c. Education Committee: Bernie Ferry – Joint RDOD with Lebanon KC will be Sat. Oct. 23 at Tractor Supply Co. on Rt. 72 in Quentin. 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. Will have four rings with activities. Could use more people with dogs for Meet the Breeds and for set-up and tear-down. We are looking at conducting a joint Canine Experience event in the future.
